Meeting called to order at 6:30 p.m.

PROPOSED BUDGET FOR 2019-2020

Supervisor Manoleas announced that the Board has had two meetings on the budget. Basically the Board has agreed to this budget and voted to present this budget to the public. Water funds again are very healthy.

Kathy March commented that the Township did good on replacing the assessor because she is a very pleasant lady. She also had other concerns pertaining to page 11 of the budget listing reimbursements to the General from the Water Department. She had questions on what this involves.
