Meeting called to order by Supervisor Manoleas at 2:00 p.m.

- ✓ Motion by Clerk Turner support from Supervisor Manoleas to add Firecatt invoice to the agenda. Yeas: 7 Nays: 0 Motion carried.

Public Comment: Helen Trottier was concerned about the compensation for the immediate supervisor over the employees. Who was this person? The person is Trustee Neruda and this topic will be discussed later in the meeting. It is on the agenda.

Bill Dedoe thanked the Clerk and Deputy Clerk for all the hard work they put into the election. He realized this because he was an election inspector and got first-hand behind the scenes experience. He also suggested that the Township look into purchasing new voting booths.

OLD UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

COMPENSATION FOR IMMEDIATE SUPERVISOR OF THE TOWNSHIP EMPLOYEES AND DPW EMPLOYEES

COMCAST BUSINESS:

Supervisor Manoleas asked Stacey Smith to come into the meeting and explain this Comcast Business to the Board. It will cost more but it will be a lot faster plus when others in the area get interrupted the Township will continue working. This plan will give the township new phones, as well.
